NAKURU COUNTY GOVERNOR'S CUP 2026

RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. Player eligibility:

- All players holding a Nakuru county voter's cards are eligible to play regardless of their area of origin. A team shall not register, field or retain any foreign player.
 - A team shall at every stage of the competition hold 30 members (3 officials and 27 players). of the 27 players, 20 shall have national id cards/passport and be dully registered as voters within any polling Centre in Nakuru county and 7 underage players shall be of 17years. (Only a maximum of 3 players of the 17 years can feature in match at the same time).
2. The fixtures of every ward shall be generated and posted at fkfleagues.com by the federation website through its technical team.
 3. Matches shall be on knock out bases at ward level and played 30 minutes each half.
 4. We shall only have one winner per ward advancing to the next round which is the sub counties level.
 5. Tournament coordinators will take group photos of every team on every match for verification.
 6. Tournament coordinators will handle all matches logistic. Where cases arise, he/she will forward the same to the disputes committee who will determine the case within the shortest period of time and a verdict rendered.
 7. The coordinators shall not receive any case after kick off of the matches.
 8. The tournament rules will be available for all stakeholders at the website www.fkfleagues.co.ke
 9. Walkovers shall be awarded if any team is late by 20 minutes after kickoff time.
 10. A team that causes abandonment of any match will risk losing the match on a 2-0 rule basis.
 11. WHERE NOT EXPRESSLY STATED IN THE ABOVE RULES, FIFA/FKF RULES SHALL APPLY. THE FKF RULE AND REGULATIONS (FKF RULE BOOK) SHALL BE THE REFERENCE
